

Harvest and Stitches 2017 Shop Hop Memory Quilt

Enjoy visiting all 16 Participating shops – and be sure to pick up your 6” block pattern and fabric at each shop you visit.

Planning on making all your blocks into a project? Perfect! We’ve created the following setting instructions to help you do just that. Check out this pretty table runner!

This time around – we’ve chosen a palette of rich fall colors, perfect for this time of year!

Fabric Requirements:

- (16) 6” (Finished) Quilt Blocks – 1 block supplied by each shop you visit
 - Sashing and Setting Triangles: 3/4 Yard
 - Backing: 2 Yards
 - Binding: 3/8 Yard
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Cutting Instructions:

- **Sashing:**
 - (22) @ 1 1/2” x 6 1/2”
 - (2) @ 1 1/2” x 15 1/2”
 - (2) @ 1 1/2” x 22 1/2”
 - (3) @ 1 1/2” x 29 1/2”
 - **Setting Triangles:** (4) @ 8” x 8” – then cut once diagonally to make 8 triangles
 - **Binding:** (5) @ 2 1/4” x Width of Fabric
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Finished Size: 21” x 60”

General Instructions:

- **Sewing:** Use an accurate 1/4” seam
 - **Pressing:** Press seams at each sewing step before moving on to the next step.
 - **Thread:** Use a good quality 100% cotton thread for both piecing and quilting.
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Assembly Instructions:

1. **Make up each of the 16 blocks** you picked up during the Shop Hop – making certain each measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
2. **Arrange the 16 blocks as shown in diagram 1.**
 - a. **Make (2) rows of 2 blocks** and (4) rows of 3 blocks.
 - b. **Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing Strip** between each block in a row and on each end of each row.
3. **Assembling Rows (press after each step):**
 - a. **Add a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing Strip** to one long side of the two block rows.
 - b. **Add 1 Setting Triangle** to one end of each of the two block rows. See Diagram 2 for arrangement.
 - c. **Add a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing Strip** to the units created in the previous step as shown in Diagram 2. These units are Rows 1 and 6. Set Row 6 aside for now.
 - d. **Add a Setting Triangle to Row 2** (a three-block row - as shown in Diagram 2), press and then add a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $29\frac{1}{2}$ " to Row 2 (between Row 2 and 3).
 - e. **Please note** – Rows 3 and 4 have a Setting Triangle at both ends of the row.
 - f. **Repeat Step (d) for Rows 3, 4 and 5** – adding the Setting Triangles and then the Sashing Strip to separate the rows. You will need to sew partial seams at one end of each of these rows. Finish the seams once you have the Sashing Strips and Setting Triangles in place.
4. **Arrange Rows 1 - 6 and join together** – following diagram 2 for layout.
5. **Layer finished top** with batting and backing, baste and quilt as desired.
6. **Bind and label** the completed runner.
